The **JET RACK™** system works with all 'A' frame ladders that have a tool hole in the top. It can be used inside pickup & open frame trucks, vans, storage rooms, garages... virtually any vehicle or space that would benefit from organization and extra space.

**Installation:** The **JET RACK™** system is modular and runs along a rail which is secured to the storage unit. Once in place, you then secure the **JET RACK™** system to the rail with just a few bolts. Installation is complete in just a few minutes.

**How it works:** After assembly, guide the hole in the top of your ladder onto the 'receiving pin' of the **JET RACK™** system; push the ladder along the rail, raising the foot of the ladder and placing it onto the adjustable catch. That's it... you're done
